Qualifications Summary

Alan Mehlenbacher has a PhD in Economics from the University of Victoria and an MBA from Simon Fraser University. He also has an MSc from the University of British Columbia, a BS from the University of Michigan, a Certificate in Strategic Management from the American Management Association, and a CMC designation and Certificate in ISO 9000 Implementation from the Institute of Certified Management Consultants.

Dr. Mehlenbacher's areas of expertise include competition economics, environmental economics, computational models, applied econometrics, auctions, business strategic planning, and information technology management. He has experience as a manager or consultant in a wide variety of industries, including information technology, telecommunications, geomatics, engineering, distribution, transportation, construction, real estate, tourism, forestry, agriculture, health, and pharmaceuticals. His current consulting practice includes economic analyses, business valuations, cost-benefit analyses, and econometric analyses.

He is an Adjunct Assistant Professor in the University of Victoria's Economics Department where his areas of research are business competition and strategy, environmental economics, and computational models. He teaches courses in competition economics, competition policy, environmental economics, computational economics, applied econometrics, and macroeconomics. He has also taught courses in agent systems and network-centric computing in the Computer Science Department.

Dr. Mehlenbacher has provided management and economics consulting services to private and public sector managers in British Columbia, Alberta, and Alaska, and he has provided similar services as Associate Consultant with the Vancouver management consulting firms SRI Strategic Resources Inc. and The Signal Group. He was previously President of Stellar Financial Management Group and a partner in Stellar Systems Group Inc., a 70-person software development company.

His management consulting deliverables have included company valuations, advice and counsel on strategic and competitive issues, capital project valuations, strategic plans, business plans, performance measurements, executive information systems, business process designs, strategic information technology plans, and project turnaround strategies.

Economics consulting deliverables have included environmental economic cost-benefit analysis, statistical analysis of a mission-based loan fund, economic and environmental computational models, price-fixing analyses, simulations of economic growth, and simulations of bargaining.
